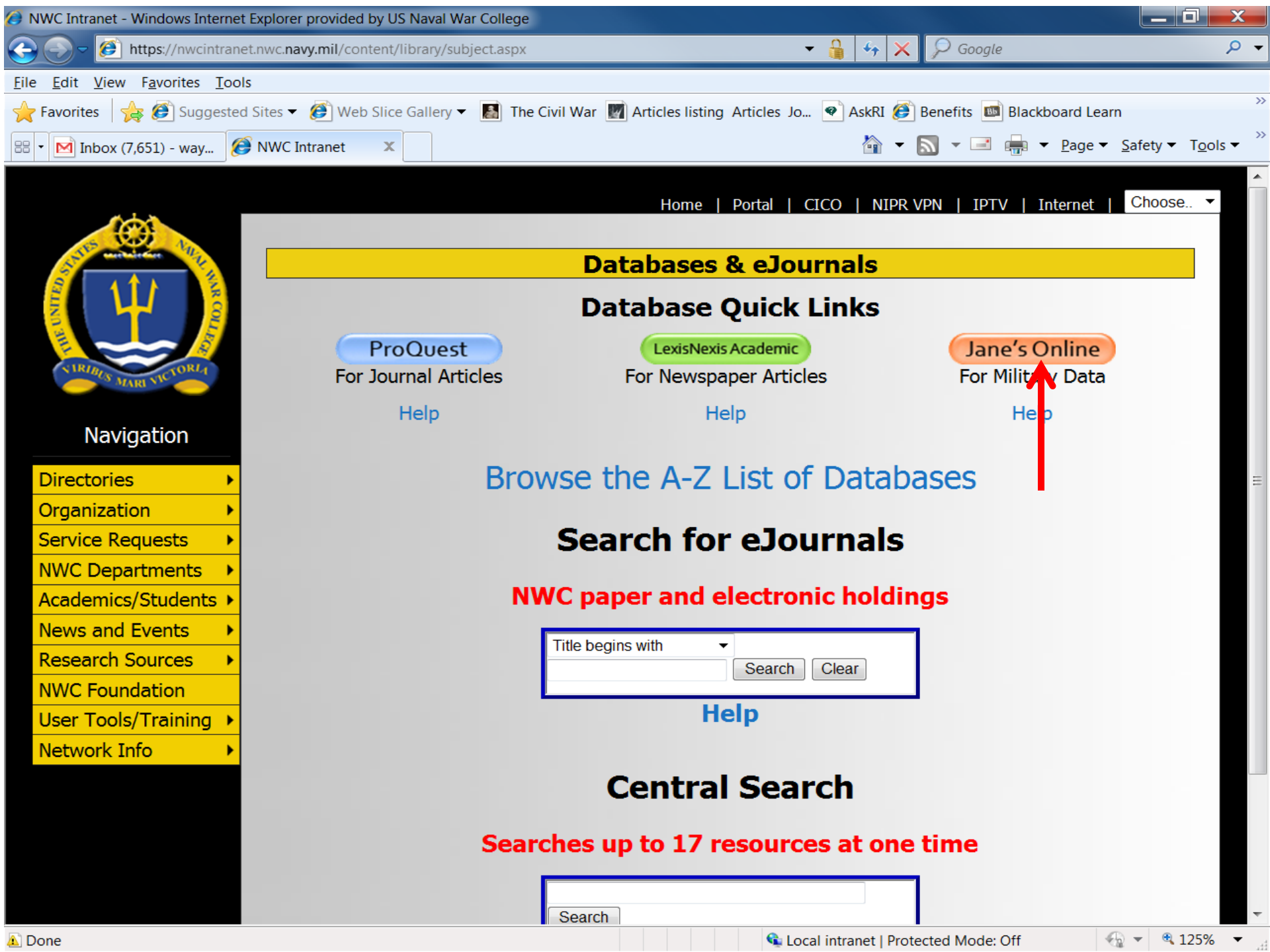

The spreadsheets below provide regional statistics for military and contextual information for all of the independent states of West Africa. Regional ratings denoting the stability of all states and territories are also provided.

Stability ratings

Country Stability Ratings provide a quantitative assessment of the stability environment of a country or autonomous territory. All sovereign countries, non-contiguous autonomous territories and de facto independent entities are included in the assessments.

To gauge stability, 24 factors (that rely on various objective sub-factors) are rated. The 24 factors are classified within five distinct groupings, namely political, social, economic, external and military and security. The stability of each factor is assessed by the Country Stability team as between 0 and 9. The various factors are then weighted according to the importance to the particular country's stability. Stability in each of these groupings is provided, with 0 being entirely unstable and 100 stable.

The weighted factors are also used to produce an overall territory stability rating, from 0 (unstable) to 100 (stable).

Finally, the team then assesses global stability levels, so that weighting and ratings are standardised across all regions.

The ratings are reviewed every quarter and updated as necessary. To simplify the presentation of these various ratings, provided below are the group and overall stability scores. These are colour coded, with green for high or very high stability, orange for moderate to low stability and red for very low stability.

Countries coded black should be considered critically unstable.

Economy

Economic overview

A civilian government was elected to office in 1999 after many years of mismanagement and squandering of resources by its military predecessors. It inherited a budget deficit of around USD3 billion, low foreign currency reserves and an enormous external debt, equal to around 80 per cent of gross domestic product (GDP). The economy had long been in decline, resulting in deteriorating infrastructure and social services. Agriculture had been seriously neglected and the business sector was stagnant. An estimated two-thirds of the population lived below the poverty datum line. Some relief came from oil revenues, which rose sharply with the boom in oil prices after 2002 and reached record levels in 2003 and 2004. Continued high oil prices, combined with relatively strong growth in the agriculture sector, led to GDP growth of around six per cent between 2006 and 2008. However, the vulnerability of Nigeria's economy to fluctuations in the oil price became evident in the latter half of 2008 when the price per barrel fell from almost USD150 to under USD50. Nevertheless, recovery in Nigeria's economy, which began in the second half of 2009, continues to be on track, with GDP growth estimated at around seven per cent in 2011.

Oil sector

Nigeria's importance to the African and global economy is now almost entirely due to its role as an oil and natural gas producer. The oil industry is the mainstay of the economy, contributing more than 95 per cent of foreign earnings. Oil production has traditionally been based on the shallow water and onshore fields of the Niger Delta, although large new discoveries have also been made further offshore, in the deep water of the Gulf of Guinea. Nevertheless, the cycles of insecurity in the Niger Delta (with heightened attacks most recently taking place between 2006-2009) have affected Nigeria's oil production and, consequently, revenues. Smuggling of stolen crude ('bunkering') and refined oil products (bought at subsidised prices) out of Nigeria has also been a huge drain on the budget and national petroleum supplies.

Reform programme

Obasanjo took a much tougher stance on economic policy from his second term in 2003. In early September 2003, he announced the formulation of a National Economic Empowerment and Development Strategy (NEEDS), which included fuel market deregulation, privatisation of power and telecommunications and civil service job cuts. The strategy was to form the basis for the country's Poverty Reduction Strategy paper, used by the World Bank and International Monetary Fund (IMF) as a framework for their financial assistance. One of the Obasanjo government's biggest successes was in tackling the national debt. Rather than opting for a long debt cancellation process under the heavily indebted poor countries (HIPC) agreement, the Nigerian government decided on a more direct approach. In April 2006, Abuja agreed to use USD12.4 billion of its oil windfall to pay off its debt to the Paris Club of major international creditors, in return for the cancellation of the rest of its USD30 billion debt to the club. Under Yar'Adua, much emphasis was placed on the goal of Nigeria becoming a top 20 world economy by 2020. This was encapsulated under his "Vision 2020" programme, through targeting areas such as corruption, infrastructure bottlenecks, the
